(a) & (b) Closed Circuit Television Cameras (CCTVs) have been installed at Manikpur station (27 cameras), Banda station (40 cameras) and Mahoba station (27 cameras) of Bundelkhand region in Uttar Pradesh. CCTV cameras are provided in station premises and at Entry/Exit gate of stations.

(c) CCTVs at Chitrakoot station are targeted for installation by October, 2022.
