# MINISTER OF STATE FOR COMMUNICATIONS (SHRI DEVUSINH CHAUHAN)

- (a) Yes Sir.
- (b) Since the launch of India Post Payments Bank (IPPB) on 01<sup>st</sup> September, 2018 with 650 branches, the bank has enabled 1.36 lakh Post Offices (including 1.10 lakh in rural areas) to provide Banking services across the country. IPPB has also equipped nearly 1.89 lakh Postmen and Gramin Dak Sevaks with smartphone and biometric device to provide Doorstep Banking Services.
