#### WATER TESTING LABORATORIES

#### †2992. SHRI ARUN KUMAR SAGAR:

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government is contemplating any proposal in regard to setting up of water testing laboratories in the country especially in each district of backward regions;
- (b) if so, the details thereof especially in backward and rural regions;
- (c) whether any proposal has been received by the Union Government from some States to set up water testing laboratories in each district during the last three years;
- (d) if so, the details thereof especially about the backward and rural regions; and
- (e) the action taken or being taken by the Union Government thereon?

#### **ANSWER**

### MINISTER OF STATE FOR JAL SHAKTI (SHRI PRAHLAD SINGH PATEL)

(a) to (e) To make provision of potable tap water supply in adequate quantity, of prescribed quality and on regular & long-term basis to every rural household by 2024, since August, 2019, Government of India in partnership with States, is implementing Jal Jeevan Mission (JJM) – Har Ghar Jal.

Under JJM, States/ UTs can utilize upto 2% of their annual allocation for taking up water quality monitoring & surveillance activities. States/ UTs have been advised to upgrade different levels of laboratories i.e. State, district, sub-division and/ or block level and get NABL accreditation and/ or recognition. As reported by States/ UTs, State-wise number of various level drinking water quality testing laboratories set up in the country as on 13.12.2021, is **annexed**. States/ UTs have been advised to open these water quality laboratories to general public so that they can get their water samples tested on nominal rates.

Drinking Water being a State subject, it is States who plan, design, approve and implement drinking water supply schemes including setting up of labs. As such individual projects/ schemes for rural water supply are not approved at the Government of India level.
