- (a) to (b): Swachh Bharat Mission-Urban (SBM-U) 2.0 has been launched on October 1, 2021 with the following objectives:
 - (i). To achieve Sustainable Solid Waste Management.
 - (ii). To achieve Sustainable Sanitation and treatment of used water.
 - (iii). To create awareness along with large scale citizen outreach for 'jan andolan' and to institutionalize 'swachh' behaviour.
 - (iv). To create institutional capacity to effectively implement programmatic interventions to achieve mission objectives.

Relocation of stray cattle and dogs from urban areas is not an objective of the Mission.
