- (b) if so, the details of price thereof, State-wise along with rate of petrol and ATF in May, 2014; and
- (c) the reasons therefor?

(a) to (c): Prices of Aviation Turbine Fuel (ATF), petrol and diesel have been market-determined by the Government with effect from 01.04.2001, 26.06.2010 and 19.10.2014 respectively. Since then, the Public Sector Oil Marketing Companies (OMCs) take appropriate decision on pricing of these products in line with international product prices and other market conditions.

The details of final selling price of the ATF (domestic) and Petrol (retail) at four metro cities as on 01.05.2014 are as under:
