Will the Minister of New & Renewable Energy be pleased to state:

- a) whether the Government proposes to promote the Geo-thermal energy resources in Ladakh for power generation;
- b) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;
- c) whether the Government is aware about the different medicinal properties of each hot spring in Himalayan region;
- d) if so, the details thereof; and
- e) if not, the reasons therefor?

### **ANSWER**

#### THE MINISTER OF NEW & RENEWABLE ENERGY AND POWER

- (a)&(b) The Ministry of New and Renewable Energy (MNRE) has issued a letter of support to ONGC Energy Centre (OEC) for setting up 1 MW pilot geothermal power project in Puga Valley of Ladakh. OEC has also signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with UT Administration of Ladakh in this regard. The project is currently under implementation.
- (c) to (e) As per the report of the National Institute of Sowa Rigpa (NISR), Leh, traditional practitioners are using hot springs in Leh-Ladakh for treatment of arthritis, skin diseases, gastrointestinal problems, migraine, eye disorders, joint and cervical problems, etc.
