(a), (c) \& (d): Mahatma Gandhi NREGA is a demand driven wage employment programme and funds are released to the States/UTs on the basis of agreed to Labour Budget and performance of the States during the financial year and there is no provision of State/UTwise allocation of funds. State/UT wise release of funds for wage, material and administrative component in the last three financial years under Mahatma Gandhi NREGS is given at Annexure.
