FENCING ON NATIONAL HIGHWAYS

3085. DR. KALANIDHI VEERASWAMY:

Will the Minister of ROAD TRANSPORT AND HIGHWAYS

be pleased to state:

- (a) the details of the stretches having fencing on National Highways (NHs) in the country including Tamil Nadu;**
- (b) the details of the number of stretches on NHs which are still without fencing in the country including Tamil Nadu;**
- (c) whether the Government has made any plan for their fencing; and**
- (d) if so, the details thereof and the time by which it is likely to be done?**

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Fencing/ boundary wall has been provided in two operational stretches of NHAI i.e. Eastern Peripheral Expressway and Package-4 of Delhi Meerut Expressway (green field portion). Fencing has also been provided in 17 km length in NH-354E in Punjab. Fencing in partially access controlled National Highways (NHs) or NHs without access control is provided only in specific locations as per provision of Contract/Concession Agreement.

(c) & (d) Fencing is generally provided all along the expressway to make them access controlled. There is no plan for fencing all along NHs.
