#### VARIOUS DEVELOPMENT SCHEMES FOR MSME SECTOR

Will the Minister of MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES be pleased to state:

(a) the details of start-ups have received the Government funding in the State of Maharashtra;

(b) whether the Government plans to introduce any scheme or project to boost the startup mechanism in backward areas of Maharashtra, if so, the details thereof;

(c) the details of procurement from women-owned enterprises under Public Procurement for MSEs Amendment Order, 2018 during the last 3 years;

(d) the details of subsidies and credit has been disbursed under the Prime Minister's Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP) during the last 3 years; and

(e) the details of the amount disbursed under National Awards to outstanding Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) in the country and the selection criteria for the same?

### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF MICRO, SMALL AND MEDIUM ENTERPRISES (SHRI NARAYAN RANE)

(a)&(b): To promote startups across all the State/UTs including Maharashtra, Government of India has launched Startup India initiative in 2016. The Government as part of Startup India initiative has implemented Fund of Funds for Startups (FFS) Scheme and Startup India Seed Fund Scheme (SISFS) to provide financial assistance through Alternative Investment Funds (AIFs) and incubators.

As on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2021, for the State of Maharashtra, Rs. 1,847.97 crore has been invested by such AIFs, into startups, under Fund of Funds for Startups (FFS) Scheme. Also under Startup India Seed Fund Scheme, Rs. 2.10 crore has been disbursed to the selected incubators from the State of Maharashtra as on 25<sup>th</sup> November, 2021.

(c): The details of procurement from women-owned enterprises under Public Procurement Policy during the last 3 years is given below:
