(a) to (c) The National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) was launched on 21<sup>st</sup> January, 2015 and has ended on 31<sup>st</sup> March, 2019. The details of works undertaken and completed in Amaravati (Andhra Pradesh) and the funds released for the works during the Mission period of HRIDAY scheme are as under:
