- (a) whether there is a long delay in completion of four laning of National Highway (NH) that passes through Sambalpur Parliamentary Constituency in Odisha;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether any time frame is fixed to complete this project with the prescribed quality and standard; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d) Total 4 works for widening/upgradation to 4-lane have been taken up, through National Highways Authority of India (NHAI), in the Sambalpur Parliamentary Constituency in Odisha. Out of 4 works, Provisional Commercial Operation Date (PCOD) has been issued in 2 works i.e., Sambalpur Bargarh-Odisha/Chattisgarh Border of NH-6 and Binjabahal to Telebani of NH-6, on 21.06.2016 and 27.05.2021 respectively. two, works are in progress, their details such as length, progress and reasons for delay etc. are as under:
