(a) to (d): Jamshedpur airport is maintained by Tata Steel Ltd. Ministry of Civil Aviation has launched Regional Connectivity Scheme (RCS) - UDAN (Ude Desh ka Aam Nagrik) on 21-10-2016 to stimulate regional air connectivity and making air travel affordable to the masses. The primary objective of RCS is to facilitate / stimulate regional air connectivity by connecting unserved/underserved airports/heliports/water aerodromes in the country. Under the scheme, the routes connecting Jamshedpur airport have been awarded and the airport has been included in the list of airports being developed / revived under "Revival of unserved and underserved airports" scheme for operation of RCS flights. The timeline for completion of the project depends upon factors such as land acquisition, availability of mandatory clearances, financial closure etc.
