- (a) whether the Government has sanctioned any funds for the development of ports and port infrastructure in Tamil Nadu;
- (b) if so, the details of the funds allocated in the last five years, year-wise, port-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to curb the monopoly of private players in Port?

- (a) &(b) The Government of India has sanctioned projects for various ports in State of Tamil Nadu under its Sagarmala Programme. The details are in Annexure.
- (c) The Major Ports of India are regulated under Major Ports Authority Act, 1963. However, non-major Ports and their concessionaires are regulated by State Maritime Boards under respective State Governments. The State Maritime Boards are also regulated under Indian Ports Act, 1908.
