QUALITY HEALTHCARE FACILITIES AT TIRUPATI

Will the Minister of Health and Family Welfare be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to set up AIIMS hospital / college at Tirupati as part of the initiatives taken/to be taken under Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission for providing access to quality healthcare services;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (DR. BHARATI PRAVIN PAWAR)

(a) to (c) Prime Minister - Ayushman Bharat Health Infrastructure Mission does not cover establishment of new AIIMS. However, under the Pradhan Mantri Swasthya Suraksha Yojana (PMSSY), setting up of an AIIMS at Mangalagiri, in Andhra Pradesh has been approved. Further, Sri Venkateswara Institute of Medical Sciences, Tirupati, Andhra Pradesh has been upgraded at an approved cost of Rs. 120 crore under PMSSY to provide super speciality medical care facilities.
