MEASURES TO PROMOTE AYURVEDIC TREATMENT

3352. SHRI RAJAN VICHARE:

Will the Minister of **AYUSH** be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government is taking any measures to promote Ayurvedic treatment along with allopathic treatment;
- (b) If so, the details thereof;
- (c) the details of cities in which Ayurvedic facilities are being provided by the Government, State/UT-wise including Mahrashtra;
- (d) whether the Government proposes to promote Ayurveda and Unani systems of medication and treatment; and
- (e) if so, the details of funds allocated, released and utilised for promotion of Ayurveda and Unani separately during the last three years and current year till date, year-wise and State/UT-wise including Mahrashtra?

ANSWER THE MINISTER OF AYUSH (SHRI SARBANANDA SONOWAL)

(a) & (b) Government of India has adopted a strategy of Co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs), thus enabling choice to the patients for different systems of medicines under single window. The engagement of AYUSH Doctors/ paramedics and their training is supported by the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, while the support for AYUSH infrastructure, equipment/ furniture and medicines are provided by Ministry of Ayush under Centrally Sponsored Scheme of National AYUSH Mission (NAM).

Under NAM, financial assistance is being provided for Co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centers (PHCs), Community Health Centers (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs) as per the proposal received from State/UT Government through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) as per NAM guidelines.

(c) The status of Ayurvedic Hospitals and Ayurvedic Dispensaries which are functioning State/UT-wise including Maharashtra is furnished at **Annexure-I.**

(d) & (e) National Institutes under Ministry of Ayush, National Institute of Ayurveda (NIA), Jaipur, Institute of Teaching & Research in Ayurveda (ITRA), Jamnagar, All India Institute of Ayurveda (AIIA), New Delhi, North Eastern Institute of Ayurveda & Homoeopathy (NEIAH), Shillong, National Institute of Unani Medicine, Bengaluru, Karnataka and Central Council for Research in Ayurvedic Sciences (CCRAS), New Delhi & Central Council for Research in Unani Medicine (CCRUM), New Delhi inter alia engaged in to popularize Ayurveda and Unani among the masses about various patient care and other activities through Information Education Communication (IEC) materials, awareness and medical camps. Further, Government of India is implementing the Centrally Sponsored Scheme of the National AYUSH Mission (NAM) in the country through State/UT Governments for promotion and development of AYUSH system including Ayurveda and Unani systems of medication and treatment. Grant-in-aid is provided to State/UT Governments as per the proposals received through State Annual Action Plan (SAAP) as per NAM guidelines.

The Mission *inter-alia* makes provision for the following to promote AYUSH system including Ayurveda and Unani systems of medication and treatment:-

- (i) AYUSH Health & Wellness Centres under Ayushman Bharat:
- (ii) Co-location of AYUSH facilities at Primary Health Centres (PHCs), Community Health Centres (CHCs) and District Hospitals (DHs)
- (iii) Upgradation of existing standalone Government AYUSH Hospitals
- (iv) Upgradation of existing/setting up of new standalone Government/ Panchayat /Government aided AYUSH Dispensaries
- (v) Setting up of up to 10 bedded/ 30 bedded/ 50 bedded integrated AYUSH Hospitals
- (vi) Supply of essential drugs to Government AYUSH Hospitals, Government Dispensaries and Government/Government aided Teaching Institutional AYUSH Hospitals
- (vii) AYUSH Public Health Programmes- (a) National Program for Prevention and Management of Musculoskeletal Disorders, (b) Integration of AYUSH with National Programme for Prevention and Control of Cancer, Diabetes, Cardiovascular Diseases and Stroke (NPCDCS), (c) SUPRAJA (AYUSH Maternal & Neo-natal Intervention), (d) VAYO MITRA (AYUSH Geriatric Healthcare Services), (e) AYURVIDYA (Promotion of healthy lifestyle through AYUSH System in 75000 School), (f) AYUSH Mobile Medical Unit, (g) KARUNYA (AYUSH Palliative Services) & (h) National Program on AYUSH for Morbidity Management and Disability Prevention (MMDP) of Lymphatic Filariasis (lymphoedema)
- (viii) Upgradation of State Government Under-Graduate and post-Graduate Educational Institutions.
- (ix) Establishment of new AYUSH Colleges in the States where availability of AYUSH teaching institutions is inadequate in Government Sector.

Under NAM, the details of funds allocated, released and utilised for promotion AYUSH systems of Ayurveda and Unani during the last three years and current year till date, year-wise and State/UT-wise including Maharashtra is furnished at **Annexure-II.** However, under NAM, no funds are allocated system-wise.
