## **CRASH OF INDIAN AIR FORCE HELICOPTERS**

## 3379. SHRI MANISH TEWARI:

Will the Minister of DEFENCE be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that at least three Indian Air Force helicopters have crash landed since August this year, killing and injuring multiple personnel;

(b) if so, the details of similar incidents over the last five years including the details of personnel who were injured or lost their lives;

(c) whether it is a fact that one Captain and Lieutenant Colonel lost their lives after their helicopter Rudra-WSI crash landed in Ranjeet Sagar Dam on 3rd August, 2021 and if so, the details and the reasons therefor;

(d) whether it is a fact that Rudra-WSI is not meant to fly over water at low-altitudes, and yet it was ordered to do regular sorties over the vast Ranjeet Sagar Dam and if so, the reasons thereof; and

(e) whether it is a fact that the pilots were not given specialized training required to fly over water, if so, the reasons therefor and the corrective measures taken by the Government in this regard?

## A N S W E R

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF DEFENCE (SHRI AJAY BHATT)

(a) & (b): No, Sir. Only two Indian Air Force Helicopters have crash landed since August this year. Details of all Helicopter Accidents in last five years in all three services are appended below:-

(c) & (d): Yes, Sir. Lt Col A S Bath and Capt Jayant Joshi lost their lives after their helicopter Rudra-WSI crash landed in Ranjeet Sagar Dam on  $3^{rd}$  August 2021. There is no restriction on the helicopter flying over water. However, low flying over water needs specific authorisation. A Court of Inquiry has been ordered to investigate the crash.

(e) The training has been structured to meet the operational requirements. However, operations over large expanse of water are restricted and generally a fraction of the total overall flying. Nevertheless, all recommendations of the Court of Inquiry are implemented to avoid recurrence of accidents.
