Promotion of Rural and Indigenous/Tribal Games

351. SHRI JAYANT SINHA:

Will the Minister of YOUTH AFFAIRS AND SPORTS be pleased to state:

(a) the games identified under the "promotion of rural and indigenous/tribal games" component of Khelo India;

(b) the details and the number of annual national competitions/activities/demonstrations held for rural and indigenous/tribal games since 2018 and the games for which competitions have been held;

(c) the number of NGOs and sports federations/associations to whom financial support has been provided for promotion of these games since 2018 and the amount given, State-wise; and

(d) the number of top sports persons identified for these games, State-wise?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF YOUTH AFFAIRS & SPORTS { SHRI ANURAG SINGH THAKUR }

(a) Mallakhamb, Kalaripayattu, Gatka, Thang-Ta, Yogasana and Silambam have been identified for promotion by this Ministry under the "Promotion of rural and indigenous/tribal games" component of the Khelo India Scheme.

(b) Demonstration events for Mallakhamb, Thang-Ta, Kalaripayattu and Gatka were held during the 3rd edition of the Khelo India Youth Games, 2020 at Guwahati, Assam. Further, thirty-six sports competitions/events were organised in 2019-20 by this Ministry as a part of the Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat programme to promote indigenous and tribal games in various disciplines, namely, Gatka, Roll Ball, Tug of War, Kalaripayattu, Thang-Ta, Kho-Kho, Mallakhamb, Shooting Ball, Sqay, Kabaddi, etc. in different parts of the country.

(c) Four National Sports Federations (NSFs) have been provided financial assistance under the "Promotion of rural and indigenous/tribal games" component of the Khelo India Scheme as per the details tabulated below. State-wise data is not maintained in this regard in this Ministry.
