FUNDS TO PRADHAN MANTRI KAUSHAL VIKAS YOJANA (PMKVY)

3576. DR. VISHNU PRASAD M.K.:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the present status of the implementation of Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) and the achievements made under the scheme, so far;
- (b) the list of centres set up in the State of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat district-wise;
- (c) the amount of funds allocated, disbursed and utilised, State-wise;
- (d) the number of beneficiaries of PMKVY in Tamil Nadu, particularly in Thiruvannamalai district of Tamil Nadu; and
- (e) the amount of funds allocated, disbursed and utilised for the aforesaid project?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

- (a) Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) was launched in 2015. Presently, the third phase of PMKVY i.e. PMKVY 3.0 is being implemented across the country. Since inception, till 21.11.2021, 1.32 crore candidates have been benefitted from the PMKVY across the country.
- (b) Under PMKVY, short term training is being imparted through skill development Training Centres (TCs) including Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendras (PMKKs). The TCs are accredited and affiliated through single online platform i.e. Skill India Portal (SIP). Further, Ministry promotes establishment of model and aspirational skill centres known as Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Kendra (PMKK) in every district for imparting skill training in Public Private Partnership (PPP) mode throughout the country, including State of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat. The district-wise number of TCs including PMKKs in the State of Tamil Nadu, Andhra Pradesh and Gujarat, is given at *Annexure I*.
- (c) The PMKVY except PMKVY 1.0 (2015-16) has two components, namely Centrally Sponsored Centrally Managed (CSCM) component being implemented through National Skill Development Corporation (NSDC) and Centrally Sponsored State Managed (CSSM) component being implemented through State Skill Development Mission of the State/UT.

Under CSCM component of PMKVY, there is no provision of State-wise funds allocation. Since inception of the PMKVY i.e. 2015, as on 21.11.2021, an amount of Rs. 7,921.02 crore has been disbursed to implementing agency i.e. NSDC for the implementation of the scheme.

Under CSSM component of PMKVY, funds and corresponding physical targets have been allocated to the States/UTs for the implementation of scheme through State Skill Development Missions (SSDMs). Since incorporation of State component i.e. 2016, as on 21.11.2021, an amount of Rs. 1,187 crore has been disbursed to States/UTs for the implementation of the scheme. The State/UT-wise funds allocated, disbursed and utilized by the State under PMKVY 2.0 and PMKVY 3.0, as on 21.11.2021, is given at *Annexure II*.

- (d) Under PMKVY, as on 21.11.2021, 7,36,143 candidates have been benefitted in the State of Tamil Nadu including 27,574 from Thiruvannamalai district.
