SKILL TRAINING DOMESTIC WORKERS

3593. SHRI PALLAB LOCHAN DAS:

Will the Minister of SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP be pleased to state:

- (a) the initiatives undertaken by the Government to provide skill training to domestic workers; and
- (b) the details of such initiatives/schemes undertaken by the Government to provide skill training to domestic and workers working in unorganized sector?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF SKILL DEVELOPMENT AND ENTREPRENEURSHIP (SHRI RAJEEV CHANDRASEKHAR)

(a) Under Skill India Mission, Ministry of Skill Development and Entrepreneurship (MSDE) is implementing Pradhan Mantri Kaushal Vikas Yojana (PMKVY) under which training/orientation is being imparted to candidates in various National Skill Qualification Framework (NSQF) aligned job roles across 37 sectors, including Domestic Workers Sector.

In the Domestic Workers Sector, training/orientation is given to candidates in four job roles namely, child caretaker (non-clinical), elderly caretaker (non-clinical), general housekeeper and housekeeper-cum-cook aligned to the Domestic Workers Sector Skill Council.

(b) Under PMKVY, as on 21.11.2021, around 2 lakh candidates have been trained / oriented in the Domestic Worker Sector.

Further, 2.61 lakh candidates have been trained under Domestic Worker Sector Skill Council across various schemes/initiatives other than PMKVY which include CSR (Corporate Social Responsibility) / Fee Based projects, and Govt. of India and State funded projects.
