NON-AGRICULTURAL INFORMAL SECTOR

3601. SHRI PARVESH SAHIB SINGH VERMA:

Will the Minister of LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT be pleased to state:

- (a)the estimated size of the non-agricultural informal sector in the country as a percentage of the total informal sector, State-wise;
- (b)the policy in place/in the pipelines for helping small and informal firms grow over time into medium or larger formal sector firms; and
- (c)whether the Government is of the view that an urban social welfare programme along the lines of the National Rural Employment Guarantee Act is necessary for upliftment of the urban informal class?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE FOR LABOUR AND EMPLOYMENT (SHRI RAMESWAR TELI)

(a): As per the Periodic Labour Force Survey (PLFS), during 2019-20, the share of workers in informal sector among total workers in usual stasus (ps+ss) engaged in non- agricultural sector was 69.5%. The Statewise percentage share of workers in informal sector among total workers engaged in non-agricultural sector is annexed.

(b) to (c): In order to help small scale firms, the Government has launched several schemes viz. Khadi Vikas Yojana (KVY), Modified Market Development Assistance (MMDA), Gramodyog Vikas Yojana, Pradhan Mantri Employment Generation Programme (PMEGP), Coir Vikas Scheme of Funds Regeneration of Traditional Industries Yoiana. (SFURTI), A Scheme for Promoting Innovation, Rural Industry and Entrepreneurship (ASPIRE), Credit Linked Capital Subsidy and Technology up-gradation Scheme (CLCSTUS) etc. by the Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises. Furthermore, the Government is Implementing schemes for the urban informal class through Deendayal Antyodaya **Yojana-National** Urban Livelihoods Mission (DAY-NULM) and PMSVANidhi to provide affordable Working Capital loan to street vendors.
