(a) to (b): The Agricultural Marketing Infrastructure (AMI), a sub-scheme of Integrated Scheme for Agricultural Marketing (ISAM) is demand driven scheme and therefore, no State/District-wise allocation has been made. However, since inception i.e. from 01.04.2001 and up to 30.09.2021, a total of 2564 beneficiaries of Agricultural Marketing infrastructure have been assisted in West Bengal under AMI sub-scheme of ISAM.

Further as on date, total 24 applications have been received from West Bengal. The district-wise details are at Annexure - I.
