STRENGTHENING OF LIVESTOCK SECTOR

3766. SHRIMATI JASKAUR MEENA:

Will the Minister of FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING मत्स्यपालन, पशुपालन और डेयरी मंत्री be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to strengthen livestock sector in the country, if so, the details thereof;
- (b) the details of the fund earmarked and target fixed in this regard; and
- (c) the time by which action is likely to be taken along with the details thereof?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF FISHERIES, ANIMAL HUSBANDRY AND DAIRYING (SHRI PARSHOTTAM RUPALA)

- (a) to (c) In order to strengthen livestock sector, recently, the Government has approved implementation of a **Livestock Sector Package** consisting of several activities by revising and realigning various components of following existing schemes with focused development of animal husbandry and dairying across the country for next 5 years starting from 2021-22. This package envisages Central Government's support amounting to **Rs. 9800 crore** over a duration of 5 years for leveraging total investment of **Rs. 54,618 crore** for 5 years.
 - I. Rashtriya Gokul Mission
 - II. National Programme for Dairy Development
 - III. Support to Dairy Cooperatives and Farmers Production Organisation engaged in dairy activities
 - IV. National Livestock Mission
 - V. Livestock Census and Integrated Sample Survey
 - VI. Livestock Health & Disease Control

Further, the Government is implementing schemes for animal disease control and development of dairy & animal husbandry infrastructure across the country which are as under:

- I. National Animal Disease Control Programme
- II. Animal Husbandry Infrastructure Development Fund
- III. Dairy Processing & Infrastructure Development Fund
