**(c) the details of the aims and objectives of the Police Technology Mission?**

**(a) to (c): With a view to make police more efficient and effective, regular review of its functioning and technological requirements is carried out.**

**Since 'Police' and 'Public Order' are State subjects as per the seventh Schedule of the Constitution, State Governments are primarily responsible for modernisation of their police forces. However, the Central Government is also supplementing the technological modernization efforts of the State/UT Governments by funding them through the scheme of 'Umbrella Scheme of Modernisation of Police Forces'.**
