(a) & (b): Under the Scheme of Integrated Programme for Senior Citizens (IPSrC), sixteen proposals for Grants-in-aid (GIA) for running and maintenance of senior citizen homes have been received from the implementing agencies working in Madhya Pradesh in the financial year 2021-22, out of which, first installment of GIA has been released to four implementing agencies.

Under the Scheme of National Action Plan for Drug Demand Reduction (NAPDDR), twenty six proposals have been received from the implementing agencies working in Madhya Pradesh in the financial year 2021-22, out of which, first installment of GIA has been released to eleven implementing agencies.
