387. SHRI ASHOK MAHADEORAO NETE:

Will the Minister of HOME AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether any steps have been taken/proposed to be taken by the Government to carve out a separate Vidarbha State out of the State of Maharashtra;
- (b) if so, the details thereof; and
- (c) if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOME AFFAIRS (SHRI NITYANAND RAI)

- (a)&(b): No such proposal is under consideration with Government.
- (c): Demands and representations are received from time to time from various individuals and organizations for creation of new States. Creation of a new State has wide ramifications and has a direct bearing on the federal polity of our country. Government takes a decision on the matter of formation of new States after taking into consideration all relevant factors, and only when there is a broad consensus on the issue.
