IMPLEMENTATION OF NFSM

3880. SHRI T.R.V.S. RAMESH:

Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री be pleased to state:

- the details of the number of components being covered under the National Food Security Mission (NFSM) and the details of the number of States/districts in which the NFSM is being implemented;
- whether the Government is planning to include Tamil Nadu under NFSM to promote pulses and oilseeds cultivation and if so, the details thereof, district-wise; and
- the target likely to be set in this regard along with the funds likely to be sanctioned for this purpose, district-wise in Tamil Nadu?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE AND FARMERS WELFARE

कृषि एवं किसान कल्याण मंत्री (SHRI NARENDRA SINGH TOMAR)

(a): National Food Security Mission (NFSM) covers the component crops viz; rice, wheat, pulses, coarse cereals (maize & barley), nutri cereals (jowar, bajra, ragi & small millets), commercial crops (cotton, jute & sugarcane) and oilseeds. NFSM-Rice is being implemented in 193 districts of 24 states & UT of Jammu & Kashmir, NFSM-Wheat in 124 districts of 10 states & UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh, NFSM-Pulses in 644 districts of 28 states & UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh and NFSM-Coarse Cereals in 269 districts of 26 states & UTs of Jammu & Kashmir and Ladakh. The NFSM-Nutri-Cereals is being implemented in 212 districts of 14 states. NFSM-Cotton is implemented in 15 states, jute in 9 states and sugarcane in 13 states of the country. The NFSM-Oilseeds is implemented in 27 states and 3 UTs of the country.

(b) & (c): Tamil Nadu is already covered under NFSM-Pulses & Oilseeds. The NFSM-Pulses is implemented in 36 districts and NFSM-Oilseeds in 35 districts of Tamil Nadu. Further, in order to utilize fallow lands after rice in kharif season, Targeting Rice Fallow Area (TRFA)-Pulses is implemented in 5 districts and TRFA-Oilseeds in 3 districts of Tamil Nadu. The details of districts covered under NFSM-Pulses and NFSM-Oilseeds along with district-wise financial targets during 2021-22 is Annexed.
