LAKHPATI SELF HELP GROUP WOMEN

393. SHRI BHARTRUHARI MAHTAB:

Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has recently launched an initiative to create Lakhpati Self Help Group (SHG) women to enable rural SHG women to earn at least Rs 1 lakh per annum;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of blocks that have been covered under the National Rural Livelihood Mission till date along with funds allocated and utilized under the said Mission, State/UT wise details thereof; and
- (d) the number of Self Help Group (SHG) formed along with number of women mobilized into such SHGs, State/UT wise details thereof?

ANSWER

(a) & (b) Deendayal Antyodaya Yojana – National Rural Livelihood Mission (DAY-NRLM) a centrally sponsored scheme was launched in June 2011. It aims to reduce poverty through promotion of diversified and gainful self-employment and skilled wage employment resulting in appreciable income increase of the rural poor on sustainable basis. There are various sub-schemes like Mahila Kisan Sashaktikaran Pariyojana (MKSP), Start-up Village Entrepreneurship Programme (SVEP), Aajeevika Gramin Express Yojana (AGEY), National Rural Economic Transformation Project (NRETP), Deendayal Upadhyay Gramin Kaushalya Yojana (DDU-GKY), Rural Self Employment Training Institutes (RSETI) being implemented within the mission for enhancing the income on sustainable basis of the rural poor; The mission seeks to achieve its objective through investing in four core components viz., (i) social mobilization and promotion of sustainable community institutions of the rural poor (Self Help Groups-SHG, Village Organizations-VOs, Cluster Level Federations); (ii) financial inclusion, (iii) sustainable livelihoods; and (iv) convergence and entitlements. So within the ambit of the mission, SHG members are being facilitated for promotion of sustainable livelihood so that they may reach an aspirational goal of having minimum of a lakh rupee as annual income.

(c) As of 31st October, 2021, 6768 blocks have been covered under DAY-NRLM. The details of funds allocated and utilized State/UT wise from FY 2011-12 to FY 2021-22 is attached at Annexure –I.

(d) The number of Self Help Group (SHG) promoted along with the number of women mobilized into SHGs, State/UT wise is attached at Annexure - II.
