Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Union Government proposes to impose a ban on single use polythene bags and disposable items made of substandard plastic and polystyrene in the country and if so, the details thereof;
- (b) whether the Government is conducting any public awareness campaign in this regard and if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether the Government has formulated any norms/guidelines for the ban on single use plastics and if so, the details thereof;
- (d) whether it is a fact that 40 per cent of total plastic waste remains uncollected in India and if so the details thereof and reasons therefor;
- (e) whether various States have adopted separate norms for imposing ban on polythene bags in their States and if so, the reasons therefor;
- (f) if so, whether the Government is considering any uniform norms for all States in this regard and if so, the details thereof; and
- (g) the measures taken by the Government for management and safe disposal of plastic waste including plastic packaging in the country specially in Andaman and Nicobar Islands?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF ENVIRONMENT, FOREST AND CLIMATE CHANGE (SHRI ASHWINI KUMAR CHOUBEY)

(a) to (c): The Ministry has notified the Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021, vide GSR NO. 571 (E) on 12th August 2021, in the Gazette of India, prohibiting identified single use plastic items, which have low utility and high littering potential, by 2022.

As per the notification, the manufacture, import, stocking, distribution, sale and use of following single-use plastic, including polystyrene and expanded polystyrene, commodities shall be prohibited with effect from the 1st July, 2022:-

- (a)ear buds with plastic sticks, plastic sticks for balloons, plastic flags, candy sticks, ice-cream sticks, polystyrene [Thermocol] for decoration;
- (b)plates, cups, glasses, cutlery such as forks, spoons, knives, straw, trays, wrapping or packing films around sweet boxes, invitation cards, and cigarette packets, plastic or PVC banners less than 100 micron, stirrers.

The thickness of plastic carry bags has been increased from fifty microns to seventy five microns with effect from 30th September, 2021, and to one hundred and twenty microns with effect from the 31st December, 2022.

The Government has been taking measures for awareness generation towards elimination of single use plastics and effective implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016. The Ministry has organized "Awareness Campaign on Single Use Plastic – 2021". Further, the Ministry has also organized pan India essay writing competition on the theme for spreading awareness amongst school students in the country. To encourage innovation in development of alternatives to identified single use plastic items and digital solutions to plastic waste management, the India Plastic Challenge – Hackathon2021, has been organized for students of Higher Educational Institutions and start-ups recognized under Startup India Initiative.

- (d): Based upon a Central Pollution Control Board (CPCB) study it is estimated that 60% of the total plastic waste generated in the country, is collected and recycled.
- (e) to (g): The restriction on thickness of plastic carry bags is given Plastic Waste Management Amendment Rules, 2021. Over and above the Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, as amended, thirty Four states/UTs have issued notifications/orders, as per their enactments, to introduce regulations pertaining to complete or partial ban on plastic carry bags and/or identified single-use plastic items. The details are annexed.

The Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, as amended provide the statutory framework for environmentally sound management of plastic waste in the country. The following steps have been taken to strengthen implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016 and also to reduce the use of identified single use plastic items:

- (i) The States/UTs have been requested to constitute a Special Task Force under Chairpersonship of Chief Secretary/Administrator for elimination of single use plastics and effective implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016. Andaman and Nicobar Islands Administration has constituted the Special Task Force under Chairpersonship of Chief Secretary. A National Level Taskforce has also been constituted by the Ministry for taking coordinated efforts to eliminate identified single use plastic items and effective implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016.
- (ii) The State /UT Governments and concerned Central Ministries/Departments have also been requested for the development of a comprehensive action plan for elimination of single use plastics and effective implementation of Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, and its implementation in a time bound manner.

- (iii) Directions under Section 5 of Environment (Protection) Act, 1986, have been issued to all States/Union Territoriesinter alia for setting up for institutional mechanism for strengthening enforcement of Plastic Waste Management (PWM) Rules, 2016.
- (iv) The Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change has notified the draft Regulations on the Extended Producer Responsibility for plastic packaging under Plastic Waste Management Rules, 2016, as amended from time to time, in the Gazette of India vide GSR No. 722 (E) on 6th October, 2021 for public consultation.
- (v) Additional Central Assistance is also provided to States and Union territories for solid waste management including plastic waste management, under Swachh Bharat Mission Urban and Swachh Bharat Mission Grameen.
