#### **TECHNOLOGY UPGRADATION AND MODERNIZATION**

#### **†577. SHRI RAMCHARAN BOHRA:**

#### Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Railways is formulating any scheme to attract foreign investment in sectors like technological upgradation and modernization;

(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether the Railways also proposes to privatize certain areas of its operation; and

(d) if so, the details thereof?

#### ANSWER

# MINISTER OF RAILWAYS, COMMUNICATIONS AND ELECTRONICS & INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (SHRI ASHWINI VAISHNAW)

(a) and (b): Foreign Direct Investment (FDI) has already been allowed 100% on automatic route in Railway Sector (except the prohibited activity i.e. Railway Operation) since 22<sup>nd</sup> August, 2014 as per the consolidated FDI Policy of Government of India. The major activities in Railway Sector where FDI is allowed 100% are:-

- (i) Suburban corridor projects through PPP,
- (ii) High speed train project;
- (iii) Dedicated freight lines;
- (iv) Rolling stock including train sets and locomotives/ coaches manufacturing and maintenance facilities;
- (v) Railway Electrification;

- (vi) Signalling systems;
- (vii) Freight Terminals;
- (viii) Passenger terminals;
- (ix) Infrastructure in industrial part pertaining to railway line/ sidings including electrified railway lines and connectivities to main railway line; and
- (x) Mass Rapid Transport Systems.

As per the figure compiled by Department of Promotion of Industry and Internal Trade (DPIIT) the total FDI received in Railway sector since 2014-15 to 2021-22 (Upto June, 2021) is approx. 719.98 million US dollars.

(c) and (d): There is no proposal to privatize any area of operation of Railways. However, Public Private Partnerships and out-sourcing of certain facilities like cleaning, pay and use toilets, retiring rooms, parking etc. is done on need based manner to improve efficiency. There is a proposal to use Public Private Partnership mode for inducting modern rakes to run passenger trains on select routes with an objective to provide improved service delivery to passengers.
