CCTV IN TRAINS AND STATIONS

645. SHRIMATI MANEKA SANJAY GANDHI

Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Ministry has installed CCTV cameras in all the coaches of the trains in the country and if so, the details thereof;**
- (b) whether CCTV cameras have been installed in all the railway stations in the country and if so, the details thereof; and**
- (c) whether there has been a fall in the incidences of crimes in railway since the installation of CCTV cameras?**

(a) Ministry of Railways have approved works for installation of Closed Circuit Television (CCTV) Cameras in all train coaches including EMUs and passenger trains. CCTV Cameras have already been provided in 4934 coaches. Zone-wise details are appended as Appendix-I.

(b) Indian Railways have approved works for provision of CCTV Camera at all stations except halt stations. So far, CCTV Cameras have been installed at total 838 stations. Zone-wise details are appended as Appendix-II.

(c) Policing on Railways being a State subject, prevention of crime, registration of cases, their investigation and maintenance of law & order in Railway premises as well as on running trains are the statutory responsibility of the State Governments, which they discharge through Government Railway Police (GRP)/District Police. However, Railway Protection Force (RPF) supplements the efforts of GRP to provide better protection and security of passenger area & passengers. Cases of Indian Penal Code (IPC) crimes are registered and investigated by the concerned Government Railway Police.

As per data provided by GRP, the incidence of crime on Railways shows a decreasing trend during last three years from 2018 to 2020.
