Ministry of Mines has circulated guidelines for Pradhan Mantri Khanij KshetraKalyanYojna (PMKKKY) on 16.09.2015 to be implemented by the District Mineral Foundations (DMF) for taking up development and welfare projects/programs in mining affected areas.
- (d) to (f): Ministry of Mines has set up a project monitoring unit at the central level to coordinate with the DMF across the country to collate data as well as monitor the expenditure incurred from the fund.
