673. SHRI M. BADRUDDIN AJMAL:

Will the Minister of STATISTICS AND PROGRAMME IMPLEMENTATION be pleased to State:

(a) the per capita income noted during the last three years in the country, State-wise;

(b) whether there has been huge difference in per capita income of various States during the last five years;

(c) if so, the details thereof, State-wise including Assam;

(d) the urban and rural per capita income differentials in the country during each of the last three years and the current year; and

(e) the corrective steps taken/being taken by the Government to bridge the gap?

ANSWER

(a): Per Capita Net National Income of the country from 2018-19 to 2020-21 at current and constant (2011-12) prices is as under:

(b): As per the latest information received from State Governments, State/ Union Territory-wise range of Per Capita Income, measured in terms of Net State Domestic Product (NSDP) at current and constant (2011-12) prices for the last five years, is as under:

(c): State wise details including those of Assam are as given in Annexure.

(d): This Ministry compiles estimates of rural and urban income, in terms of Net Value Added (NVA), only in the base year of the Gross Domestic Product (GDP) series, which is currently 2011-12. The per capita NVA for the year 2011-12 for rural and urban area is Rs.40,925 and Rs.98,435 respectively.

(e): Government has been focusing on inclusive growth as reflected in its commitment of Sabka Saath, Sabka Vikas and has taken various steps to address the rural urban disparity. 'Gaon, Gareeb aur Kisan' has been at the centre of government policies. Government has been implementing a number of targeted programmes to improve the per capita income of both rural and urban India for overall balanced development in the country.

Government has also implemented the Aspirational Districts Programme aimed at comprehensive development of backward areas in six areas: (i) health & nutrition, (ii) education, (iii) agriculture & water resources, (iv) financial inclusion, (v) skill development, and (vi) basic infrastructure. Several measures have also been taken to increase growth and consumption in both rural and urban India under the Aatmanirbhar Bharat Abhiyan, including Pradhan Mantri Garib Kalyan Yojana.

The Union Budget 2021-22 has also announced a number of measures to support broad-based and inclusive economic development. Key measures include ensuring Minimum Support Price (MSP) at minimum 1.5 times the cost of production across all commodities, extension of SWAMITVA Scheme to all States/UTs, enhancing agricultural credit and infrastructure funds, investments to develop modern fishing harbours and fish landing centres, One Nation One Ration Card, Rs. 15,700 crore budget allocation to MSME Sector, etc.
