(a) the reasons for which the Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International Airport was leased to a private player after utilizing taxpayer money for its construction and upgradation;

(b) whether the Government proposes to recover the money spent on its upgradation;

(c) if so, the details thereof and if not, the reasons therefor;

(d) whether the Government has maintained data on the revenue generated by the

Lokpriya Gopinath Bordolo International Airport; and

(e) if so, the details of revenue generated between 2014 and 2021, separately indicating the profits, and if not, the reasons therefor?

ANSWER

- (a): Airports Authority of India (AAI) has leased out Lokpriya Gopinath Bordoloi International (LGBI) Airport under Public Private Partnership (PPP) in the public interest and for better management of the airport in accordance with the provisions of AAI Act, 1994 (as amended in 2003). PPP at airports has also helped AAI in enhancing its revenues and focusing on developing airports at Tier-II and Tier-III cities.
- (b) & (c): Yes Sir. As per the Concession Agreement, AAI gets an amount of Rs. 515.71 crore comprising of two components i.e. (a) deemed initial Regulatory Assets Base (RAB) for aeronautical & non- aeronautical assets and (b) Cost of Capital Work in Progress (CWIP) incurred by AAI up to the date of takeover of the airport by the Concessionaire.
- (d) & (e): Yes, Sir. The details of revenue generated between 2014 and 2021 at LGBI Airport along with the profit/loss statement are given below in Rs. Crore:
