CONSTRUCTION OF MEDIUM IRRIGATION PROJECTS IN ODISHA

Will the Minister of JAL SHAKTI be pleased to state:

(a) whether it is a fact that the progress of construction of some medium irrigation projects in Odisha is very slow;

(b) if so, the allocation of funds made for each of these projects;

(c) the target date set for the completion of these projects;

(d) the total hectares of land likely to be brought under irrigation by these projects; and

(e) the steps taken to expedite the construction work?

(a) Water resources projects are planned, funded, executed, and maintained by the State Governments themselves as per their own resources and priorities. Role of Government of India is limited to providing technical support and, in some cases, partial financial assistance under the existing schemes being implemented by the Ministry of Jal Shakti. Thus monitoring of progress of construction of medium irrigation projects in Odisha lies in the purview of Government of Odisha.

Further, under ongoing Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchayee Yojana - Accelerated Irrigation Benefit Programme (PMKSY-AIBP), financial assistance to two medium irrigation projects of Odisha, namely Ret and Rukura irrigation projects, have been provided by Government of India.
