## **OPERATION OF MONORAIL IN RANCHI**

NO. 805. SHRI SANJAY SETH:

Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government has any scheme to operate monorail in Ranchi in view of the increasing papulation there;
- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) the number of needy persons provided free houses in the urban areas of Ranchi during the last two years; and
- (d) the details of the future scheme in this regard?

#### **ANSWER**

# THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

- (a): No, Sir.
- (b): Question does not arise.
- (c)& (d): In pursuance of the Government's vision of 'Housing for All', Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs (MoHUA) is implementing Pradhan Mantri Awas Yojana-Urban (PMAY-U) since 25.06.2015 for

giving Central assistance to States/ Union Territories (UTs) for providing all-weather pucca houses to all eligible urban households. Central Government provides different levels of financial assistance under four verticals of the Scheme. Under In-situ Slum Redevelopment (ISSR), Affordable Housing in Partnership (AHP) and Beneficiary-led individual house construction/ enhancement (BLC) verticals of the Scheme, States/ UTs/ Urban Local Bodies also make different levels of financial assistance to the beneficiaries to make the houses affordable.

In Ranchi city of Jharkhand, total 41,740 houses have so far been sanctioned under the Scheme; out of which 14,253 are completed/delivered to beneficiaries and remaining are at various stages of construction.
