Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- (a) the quantum of funds allocated and released for Warangal City under Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY), during the last five years, year wise; and
- (b) the major works that have been completed so far and the schedule of the pending works to be completed?

ANSWER

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS (SHRI KAUSHAL KISHORE)

(a): The National Heritage City Development and Augmentation Yojana (HRIDAY) was launched on 21st January, 2015 and has ended on 31st March, 2019. Under HRIDAY Scheme, funds were allocated to cities for the entire Mission period and not year wise. An amount of₹40.54 crore was allocated to Warangal city under HRIDAY Scheme out of which ₹ 32.82 crore have been released as per the following details:-
