Online Education in Telangana

95. SHRI ANUMULA REVANTH REDDY:

Will the Minister of EDUCATION be pleased to state:

- (a) the total number of Kendriya Vidyalayas in the Telangana State;
- (b) whether the students enrolled in Kendriya Vidyalayas have been availing online classes and if so; the percentage of schools taking online classes;
- (c) if so, the percentage of students attending such classes and whether notes are being made available to those who are unable to attend such classes; and
- (d) if not, the plans in place to recover the academic time lost to students enrolled in Kendriya Vidyalayas in Telangana?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF EDUCATION (SHRI DHARMENDRA PRADHAN)

(a) Presently, 35 Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) are functioning in the State of Telangana.

(b) & (c) Blended mode of teaching learning process i.e. online / offline is going on in all 35 Kendriya Vidyalayas of Telangana. Approximately 50% students are attending online classes and the rest of the students are attending physical classes with staggered timing.

(d) Kendriya Vidyalaya Sangathan has provided all the possible support to the students on academic front. Besides, online as well as offline tools were provided to the students to bridge the learning gaps.
