959. SHRI MOHAMMED FAIZAL P.P.:

Will the Minister of WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:

- (a) the present implementation status of the National Tracking System for Missing and Vulnerable Children, including details of participating States, State/UT-wise;
- (b) the number of cases of missing and found persons reported on the portal during each of the last six years; and
- (c) the frequency at which details about found and rehabilitated children are updated on the portal?

ANSWER

MINISTER OF WOMEN AND CHILD DEVELOPMENT (SHRIMATI SMRITI ZUBIN IRANI)

(a) to (c): The Ministry of Women and Child Development has created "TrackChild Portal", to track the missing and found children. Police Stations, Juvenile Justice Boards and Child Care Institutions are required to update the information about missing and found children regularly. The state/UT-wise and year-wise total number of cases of missing and found children reported on the portal in the last six years is at Annexure-I and the frequency at which details about found and rehabilitated children is at Annexure-II.
