(a) to (d) Public Data Offices (PDOs) are established under Prime Minister Wi-Fi Access Network Interface (PM-WANI) framework for providing broadband services. Under the PM-WANI framework, any entity can be a Public Data Office. Setting up of Public Data Offices by various entities is based on their own techno-commercial assessment and therefore, no targets have been fixed by the Government. No PDO has been set up by BSNL under this framework.
