STATEMENT IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) to (c) of LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 127 FOR 10.02.2022 REGARDING "CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PARKING BAYS".

(a) & (b) Present status with regard to progress made in the construction of new parking bays in Tirupati, Vijayawada and Rajahmundry Airports is as below:

Tirupati-

Construction of new apron for three Code-C type aircraft (A321/A320/B737) is nearing completion: Sanctioned Cost: Rs.12.50 crore. Probable date of completion May 2022.

Vijayawada-

New Apron, Link & Taxiway, is being constructed to cater six Code - C aircraft which is nearing completion. Sanctioned Cost Rs.32.36 crore. Probable date of completion is March 2022.

Rajahmundry- Work of Construction of Helicopter Apron for parking of 4 AW-139 type of Helicopters is in progress. Sanctioned cost is Rs.5.56 crore. Probable date of completion is 28.02.2022.

(c) Kurnool Airport belongs to Andhra Pradesh Airports Development Corporation Ltd. (APADCL). At present, there is no such proposal.
