**Will the Minister of HOUSING AND URBAN AFFAIRS be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of funds sanctioned and released under the Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT);**
- (b) whether the target for universal coverage of tap water connection and sewerage connection has been achieved and if so, the details thereof, State-wise and for the State of Andhra Pradesh, district-wise;**
- (c) the details of the number of pedestrian sidewalks, cycling spaces, parking spaces and parks constructed under the mission, State-wise and for the State of Andhra Pradesh, district-wise; and**
- (d) the number of cities declared to have achieved hundred per cent water supply coverage in the country, State-wise?**

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## **STATEMENT**

**STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY OF PART (a) TO (d) OF THE LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION No. \*137 DUE FOR ANSWER ON 10 FEBRUARY, 2022 REGARDING “TARGETS UNDER AMRUT”:**

**(a): Atal Mission for Rejuvenation and Urban Transformation (AMRUT) was launched on 25<sup>th</sup> June 2015 in 500 selected cities across the country.**

**The approved State Annual Action Plan under AMRUT for the entire Mission period is ₹77,640 crore, which include committed Central Assistance of ₹35,990 crore. In addition, funds have also been allocated for other components of Mission, viz. Administrative and Office Expenses (A&OE), Reform Incentives and funding of spill over eligible projects of erstwhile scheme of Jawaharlal Nehru National Urban Renewal Mission (JnNURM).**

**So far, an amount of ₹36,629 crore have been released to States/Union Territories (UTs) under AMRUT, which includes ₹30,295 crore for AMRUT projects, ₹3,144 crore for eligible projects of erstwhile scheme of JnNURM, ₹1,885 as Reform Incentives and ₹1,305 crore for A&OE of States.**

**(b): Against the target to provide 139 lakh water tap connections to achieve universal coverage and 145 lakh sewer connections to enhance substantial sewerage network coverage in the AMRUT cities, 126 lakh new water tap connections and 95 lakh new sewer connections (including household coverage under septage**

**management) have been provided under AMRUT and in convergence with other schemes.**

**The State-wise details of targets and achievements of tap water and sewer connections are given at ANNEXURE-I and ANNEXURE-II. The city-wise details of water and sewer connections provided in the State of Andhra Pradesh are given at ANNEXURE-III.**

**(c): The State-wise details of non-motorized urban transport projects, i.e. pedestrian sidewalks, cycling spaces and parking spaces, taken up under AMRUT are given at ANNEXURE-IV. Details of pedestrian walkways, parking spaces and cycling tracks constructed under AMRUT are given at ANNEXURE-V. State of Andhra Pradesh has not taken up any non-motorized urban transport projects under AMRUT.**

**The State-wise details of parks and green spaces projects taken up under AMRUT are given at ANNEXURE-VI. The city-wise details of parks and green spaces projects taken up under AMRUT in the State of Andhra Pradesh are given at ANNEXURE-VII.**

**(d): So far, Ministry has not declared any AMRUT city to have achieved hundred per cent water supply coverage.**
