- (a) whether the Government proposes to organize recruitment camps for Army across the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State/UT-wise including Tonk and Sawai Madhopur districts of Rajasthan;
- (c) the total number of recruitment camps organized along with the recruitments made in all three wings of the armed forces particularly from the rural and backward areas of the country during each of the last three years, State/UT-wise;
- (d) the total number of recruitment centers existing at present, State/UT-wise; and
- (e) the steps taken by the Government to recruit youths in all three wings of armed forces from across the country particularly from rural areas during the current financial year?

- (a) & (b): No Sir. Recruitment rallies are suspended due to the prevailing COVID-19 pandemic situation in the country since July, 2021.
- (c) (i) The details of Army Recruitment rallies including rural and urban distribution is as under:

- (ii) The Indian Navy has fully migrated to an online application based process called Indian Navy Entrance Test. Therefore, no recruitment campaigns are organised in any State/UT.
- (iii) The Indian Air Force conducts recruitment by Schedule Test for Airmen Recruitment (STAR) online test every six months. In addition, recruitment rallies are conducted with a view to cover low represented, low response, remote areas to maintain demographic balance and candidates only from designated districts covered in the rally are permitted to appear.
- (iv) Recruitment data State/UT wise is placed at Annexure I.
- (d) List of Army Recruiting Offices is placed at Annexure II.
- (e) Recruitment activities have been suspended since July, 2021 due to COVID-19 pandemic.
