(b) if so, the details thereof;

(c) whether NCERT has established a Department of Curriculum Studies and also a Curriculum Group;

(d) the difference between the mandates of the said Department and the Group; and

(e) the names of academic members of the Department and Group respectively along with their qualifications to be the part of the Curriculum Group?

(a) & (b) Yes, National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) has been given the mandate to prepare the National Curriculum Framework for school education under para 4.30 of National Education Policy 2020. The National Curriculum Framework is being prepared by NCERT under the guidance of National Steering Committee set up by the Ministry of Education, Government of India.

(c) & (d) There is a Department of Curriculum Studies and Development in NCERT which looks after curriculum matters.
