(b) Does not arise.

(c) There is a Zonal Railway Training Institute functioning at Chandausi under the same Moradabad Division of Northern Railway which caters to the training of Assistant Loco Pilots / Loco Pilots. There are two Divisional Permanent Way Training Centres functional at Haridwar and Lucknow where Railway Track Training is imparted.

Besides these, a Divisional Training Centre (Traffic) is functional at Shahjahanpur where training related to Traffic department is imparted.
