- (b) if so, the details thereof;
- (c) whether there is any proposal to connect Silchar with Aizawl under Bharatmala Pariyojana; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 237 ANSWERED ON 17.03.2022 ASKED BY DR. RAJDEEP ROY REGARDING FOUR-LANNING OF SILCHAR-IMPHAL HIGHWAY

- (a) and (b) Development of Silchar to Imphal road section of NH-37 has been taken up in two parts.
 - i. Feasibility study for four lane of Silchar to Jiribam section has been taken up and based on the outcome of the feasibility study, decision on 4-lane shall be taken.
 - ii. Jiribam to Imphal section does not qualify for 4-lane and its development to 2 lane with paved shoulder for total length of 202.70 km has been taken in 07 packages. Out of this, work in 05 Packages (total length= 128.006 km) have been awarded and remaining 02 packages are in the tendering process.

(c) and (d) Yes Sir, the stretch from Silchar- Sirang (Aizawl) NH 306 (old NH 54) is under Bharatmala Pariyojana. Entire stretch of 136.40 km has been divided into 8 packages, out of which 4 packages of 65.80 km have been awarded and remaining 4 packages 70.60 km are under DPR stage.
