- (a) Central Government Schools namely Kendriya Vidyalayas (KVs) and Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas (JNVs) are under the Department of School Education & Literacy, Ministry of Education. Presently, 35 KVs and 15 JNVs are functioning in the State of Andhra Pradesh. The District-wise details are at **Annexure-I.**
- (b) The details of the gender-wise students enrolled, teacher-to-pupil ratio at primary, secondary and senior secondary in each KV in the State of Andhra Pradesh are at **Annexure II.** The details of the gender-wise students enrolled, teacher-to-pupil ratio at secondary and senior secondary in each JNV in the State of Andhra Pradesh are at **Annexure III.** No case of dropout has been reported in KVs and JNVs functioning in the State of Andhra Pradesh.

Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas are from classes VI to XII. Trained Graduate Teachers (TGTs) are taking classes up to Class X whereas, Post Graduate Teachers (PGTs) are taking lower classes also other than classes XI & XII. Hence, there is no clear demarcation of classes being handled by TGT & PGT of Secondary & Senior Secondary levels. Hence, separate teacher-to-Pupil ratio is not available.

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
