Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

- a) the number of operational Vocational Training Centres with placement facilities for Tribals including Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) in Andhra Pradesh;
- b) the number of beneficiaries from PVTGs benefitted from the Vocational Training Centres in the State:
- c) whether there is a proposal to set up new training Centres in the State; and
- d) if so, the details thereof?

(a) to (d): As informed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh, 23 Youth Training Centres are functioning in the state for providing training to all STs including PVTGs, and 5,132 students have been trained in the training centers from 2015-16 to 2021-22. Further, Government of Andhra Pradesh has informed that Tribal Welfare Department (TRICOR) has taken up many initiatives like Direct Placements, Pre-Examination Coaching, Training & Placements, Self-Employment (Entrepreneurship Development Trainings, Contractor Development Program etc.), Bhavitha programs in collaboration with Andhra Pradesh State Skill Development Corporation (APSSDC). An MoU was entered with APSSDC on 22nd August, 2015 as strategic partner to impart training in various sectors to ST youth at all (23) YTCs. Consequent on entering MoU with the APSSDC has conducted self-employment Training to the unemployed ST youth in all (23) YTCs. The details of trainees / trades are as follows:

Besides, under Van Dhan Vikas Karyakram, which is targeted at livelihood generation for tribals, traditional knowledge and skill sets of tribals are enhanced by adding technology & IT to help them becoming self-reliant and entrepreneurs. Under this scheme, tribal community owned Minor Forest Produce (MFP) centric multi-purpose Van Dhan Vikas Kendras (VDVKs) are set up in districts with significant tribal population. The members are given skill training and also provided tool kits for processing of MFP and development of value chain. The details about the number of VDVKs sanctioned during the last three years with beneficiaries in respect of Andhra Pradesh are as follows.
