(a) Data related to Stray Cattle and Stray Dogs are captured in the Livestock Census. As per the 20<sup>th</sup> Livestock Census held in 2019, there are 50,21,587 number of stray cattle and 1,53,09,355 number of stray dogs in the country.

The panchayats and local municipalities are empowered to establish and run Cattle Pounds (Kanji Houses)/ Gaushala Shelters (community assets) at their respective jurisdiction.
