- (a) whether the budgetary promise to upgrade 22,000 Rural Haats to Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs) is in progress;
- (b) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;
- (c) whether any strategy has been made for including public-private participation and use of technology to increase the capacity of such Rural Haats; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a) TO (d) OF LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 479 FOR ANSWER ON 05.04.2022 BY SHRI CHANDESHWAR PRASAD REGARDING "UPGRADATION OF RURAL HAATS TO GRAMIN AGRICULTURAL MARKETS".

(a) to (d): Based on the proposals received from the State Governments/ UTs, the Government is developing and upgrading rural haats into Gramin Agricultural Markets (GrAMs). The development and upgradation of physical infrastructure of rural haats under control of Panchayats through States/ Union Territories is undertaken through Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Scheme (MGNREGS) as ongoing process for development of GrAMs.

So far, physical infrastructure/ facilities under MGNREGS have been developed in 1351 village haats while work is in progress in 1632 village haats. State-wise list is given at **Annexure-I**.

In order to efficiently manage and operate these GrAMs, Operational Guidelines have been formulated and circulated to the States. The Operational Guidelines envisage that States / UTs shall provide a level playing field to all categories of markets – public sector, private sector, Public–private partnership (PPP) sector etc.

After the development and upgradation of rural haats into GrAMs, these will be electronically linked to e-NAM platform to facilitate farmers to make direct transactions with consumers and bulk purchasers.
