NEW GOVERNMENT MEDICAL COLLEGES IN RAJASTHAN

***58. MS. DIYA KUMARI:**

Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government proposes to establish new Government Medical Colleges in Rajasthan;
- (b) if so, the details of the proposed Government Medical Colleges in Rajasthan, district-wise;
- (c) whether the Government has noted that the absence of a Government Medical College in districts with limited medical facilities affects both the health of the people as well as the education of medical-aspirants; and
- (d) if so, details of the steps being taken by the Government to address the inadequacy of medical facilities in such districts?

(a) to (d) To increase the availability of health professionals and to improve tertiary healthcare, the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare administers a Centrally Sponsored Scheme for “Establishment of new medical colleges attached with existing district/referral hospitals” to provide financial support to the States / UTs for establishment of medical college by upgrading the district hospitals in districts which do not have either a government or a private medical college. Fund sharing between the Central Government and States is in the ratio of 90:10 for NE/special category States and 60:40 for other States.

In three Phases of the said Scheme, a total of 23 new medical colleges in Rajasthan have been sanctioned out of which, 7 have become functional so far. Details are at **Annexure.**
